End of Rabbit classes

General Rules:

1. The Poultry show is held under The Poultry Club Rules (www.poultryclub.org)
2. The Rabbit show is held under the British Rabbit Council Show Rules (www.thebritishrabbitcouncil.org)
3. The Pigeon Show is held under National Pigeon Association Rules. (www.nationalpigeonassociation.org)
4. No Exhibitor may engage in conversation with the any Judges or Judges Stewards on the day of the show prior to the completion of all judging. Exhibitors caught ignoring this may be subject to disqualification.
5. The show will be held under any DEFRA/APHA regulations in place at the time of the event. AVPFS reserve the right to remove or exclude any exhibitor or birds, or rabbit considered to be in breach of these rules.
6. All exhibits must be bona-fide property of the exhibitors for at least 28 days prior to the show.
7. Entry fee must accompany entry form. Tickets will not be posted until payment is made.
8. All exhibits must be penned/displayed by the times stated in the schedule and no exhibits/birds removed prior to the stated time.
9. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/vendor to comply with animal transport regulations and provide the necessary paperwork if required.
10. Whilst all care will be taken of exhibits and equipment, all entries are made at exhibitor's own risk and neither the show organisers or any person employed or appointed by them shall be held liable for the loss of or for any damage sustained by any bird or rabbit while they are in their possession whether or exhibition, inspection, during boxing or any other purpose whatsoever.
11. If we reach capacity before closing dates AVPFS reserves the right to return entries in full.
12. AVPFS reserves the right to refuse any entry with no reason being given.
13. Where there is a class for male and female of the same breed, we (AVPFS) reserve the rights to amalgamate if insufficient numbers.
14. Where classes have sufficient entries, it is up to the Judge's discretion if they would like to split.
15. Rosettes will only be awarded if 3 or more exhibits are entered in a class.
16. D-cup drinkers will be provided for all Poultry & Pigeons. Rabbit exhibitors must supply their own water bottles.
