AVPFS – Winter Show

This is an open show for members and non-members of AVPFS. The show is to be held under poultry club rules. Please read show rules and regulations and Bio-security information at the end of the booklet.

You do not need to be a member of a breed club to enter their show.

Entry Fees are:

£1.50 Poultry Class (including Trios, Geese & Turkeys)

50p Egg Class

Entries close on Wednesday 10th January 2018. Entries will be closed prior if capacity is met.

Important times:

We will be at the venue from 7:30am, and penning allowed from 8am.

All birds must be in cages and exhibitors out of the cages area for judging to commence at 9:30am.

Birds can be boxed at 3:00pm.

Birds can be removed from building at 3:15pm once everybody has agreed they are ok with boxing.

Parking

Exhibitors will be able to park outside the building to unload, and then park in the adjoining carpark 50m away with space for over 200 cars. As this is hosted directly by us there is no car passes or entry tickets as per our 3 other events.

Maps will be included with entry confirmation.

Venue

Unlike our 3 other shows held in warmer months, we will be using the Stockmans building at the South of England Showground. The building has over 420m² of space, consisting of a 240m² room where we are showing Poultry, and 120m² seating area with kitchen attached for exhibitors to sit down and enjoy a cup of tea, and some lunch. (Menu included on separate form).



Food and Drink

Food and drink will be available on the day. The nearest cashpoint is a 15minute drive so please bring cash if you would like to purchase anything. Please see menu for list of food. Hot meals must be pre-ordered before 9am on show day or with entries.

If you wish to go out for lunch there are two local pubs, The Gardeners Arms 0.2mile from the hall, The Ardingly Inn 1mile. Booking will most likely be necessary if you plan to visit one of these. You will also only be a 15minute drive from Haywards Heath where there is a vast selection of pubs and restaurants.

Raffle

As this is an exhibitor only show and run by us, we will be holding a raffle. Along with a great selection of prizes from our sponsors, any prizes donated by exhibitors will be much appreciated, and tickets to be sold on the day and drawn after prize giving.

Bio Security & Bird Flu

Specific biosecurity advice for participants – as currently advised by DEFRA

Before setting out

- Check all your birds to ensure that there are no signs of serious disease, and that the birds to be exhibited are healthy
- Ensure that transport containers are clean and if practicable, disinfected.

On arrival at the gathering

- Only take essential equipment into the venue and ensure that it is either disposable, or capable of being cleansed and disinfected
- Only take in enough feed for the duration of the gathering
- At the gathering, wear clean clothing that has not been used in your bird housing: consider bringing a change of clothes to wear after the event
- Change your footwear: you should wear clean and disinfected footwear, or wear disposable over boots

During the gathering

- Ensure that only the owner of the birds, and the judges, handle them - they should clean their hands between each bird
- Ensure that any sick birds are immediately removed from the show area and placed in a separate isolation area

After the gathering

- Make sure containers and reusable equipment taken into the gathering are cleaned and disinfected as soon as possible and before being used again
- Change your clothes, preferably after leaving the gathering, or at least before entering the bird housing on returning home
- We recommend that on return from the gathering you should:
 - Keep birds taken to the gathering separate from the remaining birds for at least two weeks
 - Keep all new birds quarantined in a building well away from the main bird housing for at least 30 days
 - To prevent cross contamination, tend to isolate birds separately: wear different clothes when doing so
- If you have any concerns about the health of your birds, please contact your veterinary surgeon

In the Event of Avian Flu Cancellation

Due to the uncertainty of avian flu restrictions AVPFS will not pay any cheques in until the week before the event. If in the event of cancellation, we will destroy all cheques and return any cash, unless stated otherwise on entry forms.

Show Rules and Regulations

- Show to be held under Poultry Club of Great Britain rules (copies available on their website)
- Show will be held under and DEFRA Regulations in place at the time of event.
- Arun Valley Poultry Fanciers Society will not be held responsible for any damage/loss to any competitor or their property either at time of show or after.
- All exhibits must be penned/displayed by 9.30am. No exhibits are to be removed prior to 3:00pm on day of show. Once penned birds must not be removed by anyone other than appointed stewards and judges.
- No Exhibitor may engage in conversation with the any Judges or Judges Stewards on the day of the show prior to the completion of all judging. Exhibitors caught ignoring this may be subject to disqualification.
- Where there is a class for male and female of the same breed, we (AVPFS) reserve the rights to amalgamate if insufficient numbers.
- Duplicated entries will not be accepted.
- Rosettes will only be awarded if 3 or more exhibits are entered in a class.
- All birds must have been bona fide property of the exhibitor for at least 28 days prior to the show.
- All birds must comply with any DEFRA regulations in force at the time of the show and be transported in line with current welfare regulations. We reserve the right to remove or exclude any birds considered unhealthy.
- Juvenile exhibitors must be 16 years or younger on the day of the show.
- Pen numbers will be given on day of show.
- All persons making entries will be deemed to have read these rules and agreed to be bound by them.
