## Hatching Eggs

If you'd like to sell hatching eggs, please contact us to let us know by email, telephone, or on your egg show entry sheet Below are the rules for selling hatching eggs.

- When selling hatching eggs, they must be no more than 5 days old and should be proven to be fertile (that you have hatched from the same stock this year).
- They must be from birds who have a cockerel running with them for sufficient time to fertilise eggs provided for sale.
- All boxes must be marked with the breeder's name and telephone number. We expect providers of fertile eggs to replace eggs where the WHOLE box is shown to be infertile but not those which have failed during incubation.
- If you are selling eggs from unproven pens of birds, then this must be indicated on your box, so the buyer is aware.

# Autumn Show & International Horse Trials 2022

This September, for the first time ever our Autumn Show & Game Fair and the South of England International Horse Trials are coming together as one fantastic event. This will truly be a jam packed and perfect autumnal day out.

The newly named Autumn Show & International Horse Trials will take place on Saturday 24th and Sunday 25th September 2022 and will still feature its renowned programme of countryside sports, displays, and 'have-a-go' activities to entertain the whole family, including their canine companions. The incredible addition this year is the South of England International CCI\*\*\* and CCI\*\* Horse Trials affiliated with the FEI and including British Eventing national classes. This is the 15th anniversary of the trials, and the event attracts some of the top riders in the sport with over ten countries being represented across the weekend.

We recommend you buy in advance to guarantee entry. Tickets are limited.

Tickets are £12.60\* for adults, £10.80\* for seniors/students (\*inclusive of 10% advance discount until 16.9.22) and £8 for British Eventing members. Under 16s go FREE when accompanied by a paying adult (suggested donation of £2). Dogs welcome. Free Parking.

Members do not need to purchase tickets, simply bring along your membership card to scan at the gate.

- Celebrate the harvest season with the Women's Institute and Young Farmer's Clubs competitions and displays
- Immerse yourself in the Bees & Honey section including the South of England Honey Show
- Rare breed gundogs and terriers to see, and long dog and working gundog displays to enjoy
- Let the whole family join in with 'have a go' activities for visitors' dogs including dog agility\*, terrier racing\* and scurries
- Children are sure to love the activity trail, the farm animals in the animal barn, the funfair\* and more.
- Mouth-watering food and drink stalls and superb shopping opportunities throughout the event.

# Show Rules

Arun Valley Poultry Fanciers Society shows are held under The Poultry Club rules and exhibitors making entries agree to be bound by such rules. This applies to The Poultry Club and non-poultry club members (copies available on their website [here](#)) In addition to The Poultry Club rules the following rules also apply.

- Shows will be held under any DEFRA Regulations in place at the time of event.
- All exhibits must be penned/displayed by the times stated in the schedule and no exhibitors removed prior to the stated time.
- No Exhibitor may engage in conversation with the any Judges or Judges Stewards on the day of the show prior to the completion of all judging. Exhibitors caught ignoring this may be subject to disqualification.
- Where there is a class for male and female of the same breed, we (AVPFS) reserve the rights to amalgamate if insufficient numbers.
- Duplicated entries will not be accepted.
- Rosettes will only be awarded if 3 or more exhibits are entered in a class.
- All birds must have been bona fide property of the exhibitor for at least 28 days prior to the show.
- All birds must comply with any DEFRA regulations in force at the time of the show and be transported in line with current welfare regulations. We reserve the right to remove or exclude any birds considered unhealthy.
- Pen numbers will be given on day of show.
- Any bird can only be entered one class, and not multiple (ie. Juvenile Exhibitor & Handler)
- All persons making entries will be deemed to have read these rules and agreed to be bound by them
